- 2. Submit a copy of the acceptance letter from the school/college you plan to attend. Submit with the application or under separate cover.
- 3. Provide a personal reference from a **Holy Trinity parishioner** who is not a member of your family and who is not a member of the parish award committee or the award selection committee.* The letter should attest to your character, parish community commitment and worthiness of one of the awards. The parishioner should email the letter **directly** to <u>jeanwalsh@charter.net</u>. Applications without a letter of recommendation will not be considered for an award.
